	<p><u>REASSURING BLAZER</u> (Often called the trail diamond) <i>Informs the rider they are on a designated snowmobile trail.</i></p>	<p>5"X 7" Extended diamond, orange background with silver-gray reflective diamonds.</p>
	<p><u>CORRIDOR TRAIL SIGN</u> <i>Used to identify the corridor trail by number.</i></p>	<p>6"X 6" Yellow numbers and border with brown background. (non-reflective)</p>
	<p><u>SECONDARY TRAIL SIGN</u> <i>Used to identify the secondary trail by number.</i></p>	<p>6"X 6" Yellow numbers and border with brown background. (non-reflective)</p>
	<p><u>FOOD, LODGING, GAS, PHONE</u> <i>Informs the rider the services are near.</i></p>	<p>6"X 6" White letters on brown background. (non-reflective)</p>
