


WARNING SIGNS

The following are examples of additional warning signs for consideration.

Typical Design	Name and Use	Usual Characteristics
	JUNCTION AHEAD <i>Informs riders that they are approaching a trail intersection.</i>	12" X 12" Diamond, yellow background, black lettering.
	BRIDGE AHEAD <i>Informs riders that they are approaching a bridge which is narrower than the trail.</i>	12" X 12" Diamond, yellow background, black graphic and black lettering.
	BUMP <i>Informs riders that they are approaching a spot that is abruptly higher or lower than the trails groomed surface.</i>	12" X 12" Diamond, yellow background, black graphic and black lettering.
	STEEP HILL <i>Informs riders that they are approaching a section of trail with an exceptionally steep grade.</i>	12" X 12" Diamond, yellow background, black graphic and black lettering.
	ICE <i>Informs riders they are approaching a section of trail that may be ice covered and slippery. Proceed with caution.</i>	12" X 12" Diamond, yellow background, black graphic and black lettering.
	ICE CROSSING <i>Informs riders they are approaching a section of trail which crosses a frozen body of water.</i>	12" X 12" Diamond, yellow background, black graphic and black lettering.
	CAUTION GROOMING AT ANY HOUR <i>Informs the rider that trail grooming may be done at any hour of the day.</i>	12" X 12" Diamond, yellow background, black graphic and black lettering.
